This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English
- Decrease the number of students that receive a 'D' standard or lower in English
- Increase the percentage of Prep to Year 2 (P-2) students achieving a 'C' standard or above

Our initiatives include

- Improve P-6 student achievement in numeracy and literacy through further building staff knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum and teaching strategies for students in numeracy and literacy.
- Creating consistent quality pedagogy and practices with shared understandings of effective teaching of English in year level teams.
- Continuing to provide teacher release (TRS) for teachers to engage in collaborative data inquiry, cohort planning, mentoring, cohort case management and moderation (pre & post)
- Providing extra teacher support to further improve early years
- Providing coaching, mentoring and feedback for teachers
- Implementing the co-teaching model for literacy
- Providing writing and reading resources for early years
- Providing extra teacher staffing to enable high quality learning environment
- Enabling teachers to plan collaboratively focusing on student data and the enacted curriculum
